Year 5 Young Sports Leader training	(inc in gold membership)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 28 Y5 pupils are now Young Sports Leaders.</li> <li>- A rotation of Y5 pupils leads a sports activity for younger pupils each break time.</li> </ul>
Storage and resources for Year 5 Young Sports Leaders	£253	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Easy access to equipment for young leaders.</li> </ul>
Teaching assistant in Y1 to support the teaching of high quality PE lessons	£1200 x 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pupils change into PE kit more quickly and therefore take part in a full 2 hours of curriculum sport each week.</li> <li>- Pupils make more progress during PE lessons with the support of an additional adult.</li> </ul>
Coach hire for sports festivals	£355	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All pupils in Class 4 able to attend inter-school sports festival without charge.</li> </ul>
PSHCE Service level agreement	£865	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Planning and resource materials provided for health related education throughout the school.</li> <li>- Training provided for all teaching staff.</li> </ul>
Swimming subsidy	£800	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Life guard provided during school swimming lessons.</li> <li>- Swimming instructor provided.</li> <li>- All children able to attend swimming lessons.</li> </ul>
