PRIORITIES / OBJECTIVES

<p>FUNDING: £8926</p> <p>HLTA develops and delivers good quality lessons across the school.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organises CPD for staff in areas identified as school priority e.g. football (referee) , orienteering skills. • Promote 'Change for Life' programme across the school • Promotes 'Golden Mile' across the school • Target pupils who need encouragement to take part in sporting activities • Encourages active participation • Develops a better understanding of 'healthy living'. <p>COST TO DATE: £4000</p>
<p>Impact: Due to the change of staff, this funding supported the employment of a PPA teacher who had a specialism of PE, commencing from Nov 2014.</p> <p>The employment of this member of staff has impacted on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School was awarded the Sainsbury's Gold award for Sport provision • An increase in pupil participation in after school clubs and sporting events outside the school • The setup and active football teams for both boys and girls in the small school's league. • Support to colleagues in teaching PE. • Good CPD for staff.
<p>Playmakers Scheme:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils are confident in providing playground games that promote fitness and team building opportunities. • Provision is increased by the variety of activities provided at break / lunch times • Peer coaching • Pupils gain fundamental skills in leadership, social and team building. <p>COST TO DATE: subscription cost £50</p>
<p>Impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils actively lead activities at breaktimes to promote teamwork and fitness. • Reduced low level behaviour that was associated with football • Promoted both pupils' leadership skills and enabling pupils to take responsibility in organising the setup and running of activities • Succession planning was evident in training peers to run activities
<p>TA support for planning and organising structure and activities at breaktimes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan and organise activities at breaktimes covering sport, construction, reading, writing, creative & dance zones around the playground. • Encourage children to partake in different activities • Deter minor / low level behaviour especially in football games. <p>COST TO DATE: £1000</p>
<p>Impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils have the opportunity to take part in different activities at breaktimes e.g. knitting, K'nex, dance, drawing, bubbles etc. • Activities covered a wide range of pupil interests • Fewer incidents from football. • Pupils' engagement in other activities is increased. •
<p>Travel expenses for cluster and external sports competitions / events</p> <p>ESTIMATED COST: £300</p>
<p>Impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supports and enables all pupils to take part in sporting activities • Supported pupils travelling costs to events

The school has bought into the Cheltenham & North Tewkesbury School Sport Network.

This provides the following:

- 2 day bespoke package which may include whole staff INSET, development of curriculum, assessment or monitoring etc.
- Cluster Competitions
- CPD for staff 6 termly courses
- G&T / SEND holiday camps (for 2 of our students)
- Dance festival, Olympic multi-skills day, Tag Rugby Festival, Athletics etc.
- 12x 1hr coaching sessions: Football & Orienteering Skills

Preparation for Ofsted

COST TO DATE: £750

Impact:

- Was a factor in the school gaining the Sainsbury's Gold award.
- Extended the Sports provision for all year groups.
- Provided good CPD for all staff.
- Enabled the pupils to take part in competitive sports against similar sized schools.
- Extended the provision for G&T pupils

The school supplements After School Sports provision provided by an external provider. The provision runs alongside teacher clubs, ensuring variety and choice for children in the different keystages.

Objectives:

- Provides a range of sporting activities for all pupils
- Expertise in certain sport disciplines
- Seasonal sports are provided

Targets all keystages

ESTIMATED COST: £300

Impact:

- Enabled and promoted pupils to take part in after school provision
- Provided pupils to be taught by sports coaches in different sports disciplines
- Provided the pupils with choice

Equipment / resources purchased to supplement existing resources or provide new equipment for the provision of sport.

ESTIMATED COST: £500

Impact:

- Updated new resources to teach PE
- SOW for the new curriculum was purchased and is used by all staff to plan and assess PE standards

Provide and partially fund the following unusual / modern sporting activities for children:

- Sailing – 3hr session per week in the Summer Term estimated costs : £20 per session per child. School contribution £10 per child.
- Horse riding TBA
