PRIORITIES / OBJECTIVES

<p>FUNDING: £8810 (inc £470 b/f)</p> <p>Employment of PE Specialist develops and delivers good quality lessons across the school.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organises CPD for staff in areas identified as school priority e.g. Dance and tactical sports. • Sustains Sainsbury's Gold Sports award • Monitors sports provision in the school identifying strengths and areas for development • Target pupils who need encouragement to take part in sporting activities <p>COST TO DATE: £5000</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The employment of this member of staff has impacted on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School was awarded the Sainsbury's Gold award for Sport provision 2 years in a row. • An increase in pupil participation in after school clubs and sporting events outside the school • The setup and active football teams for both boys and girls in the small school's league. • Support to colleagues in teaching PE. • Good CPD for staff. Cricket & football coaching from external providers. • Good sporting links with an independent school and schools in the area.
<p>Playmakers Scheme:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils are confident in providing playground games that promote fitness and team building opportunities. • Provision is increased by the variety of activities provided at break / lunch times • Peer coaching • Pupils gain fundamental skills in leadership, socially and team building qualities. <p>COST TO DATE: subscription cost £50 + (playground equipment for activities £200)</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils actively lead activities at breaktimes to promote teamwork and fitness. • Reduced low level behaviour that was associated with football • Peer coaching is evident and succession planning is in place for when Y6 leave the school. • Pupils have gained fundamental skills in leading and organising activities, being able to mix with younger pupils and demonstrate how to use the equipment correctly and team building qualities. • Pupils having responsibility to lead as role models when using and taking part in activities. • Succession planning was evident in training peers to run activities.

<p>IMPACT:</p>

- Being part of the SSN was a factor in the school gaining the Sainsbury's Gold award. This was due to the SSN providing a variety of sporting activities for the school to participate.
- Extended the Sports provision for all year groups.
- Provided good CPD for all staff.
- Enabled the pupils to take part in competitive sports against similar sized schools.
- Extended the provision for G&T pupils
- Being part of the Children's race in the Cheltenham Half Marathon.
- Andoversford pupils having the opportunity to visit and use an athletics stadium in Cheltenham.

The school supplements After School Sports provision provided by an external provider. The provision runs alongside teacher clubs, ensuring variety and choice for children in the different keystages.

Objectives:

- Provides a range of sporting activities for all pupils
- Expertise in certain sport disciplines
- Seasonal sports are provided

Targets all keystages

ESTIMATED COST: £300

IMPACT:

- Enabled and promoted pupils to take part in after school provision- % of pupils taking part in after school clubs has increased, especially in sporting clubs.
- Provided pupils to be taught by sports coaches in different sports disciplines. E.g. Karate, Gloucestershire Cricket Board after school club, Cheltenham Town Football Club running a football and multiskills club.
- Provided the pupils with choice
