

Pupil Premium report 2014/15

In 2014/15 we received £9,700 in Pupil Premium funding. We used Pupil Premium funding to support the following:

- Achievement for All programme
- Interventions in reading, writing and maths
- TA support
- TA training

Impact

In Writing and Maths, 67% of pupils entitled to Pupil Premium funding achieved at least age-related expectations by the end of the academic year.

In Reading, 83% of pupils entitled to Pupil Premium funding achieved at least age-related expectations by the end of the academic year.

In Writing and Maths, 67% of pupils entitled to Pupil Premium funding made at least expected progress by the end of the academic year. This figure is lower for Reading and we are seeking to address this through:

- Replenishing and redesigning the library
- Lunchtime book club
- New reading scheme for some pupils
- Training volunteer readers
- Supportive materials for parents
- Training and materials for interventions
