Teachers are good, my children are happy and achieving well, discipline and focus, the staff are hands on, all the effort to make sure my child have all we need, family feel, teachers support, pushes children to work hard, constant communication, and involvement in activities, kind staff make you feel happy, they accept all, friendly environment. My child enjoys the friendships she has made here, friendly and supportive school, good educational standards, teachers are friendly, seeing friends, friendly environment, children are encouraged to fulfil their potential, my child has settled in quite well from Africa, the management is excellent. How can we make our school better: : Less after school clubs, more projects and activities, ensuring that children's relationships are observed at break times as some incidents are not communicated by the teachers to parents, bring the parents closer together / event. List of topics provided on a regular basis, better control over incidences, challenge our children more, keep doing all that you are currently doing, St.Luke's is a good school, more days with parents in class - it is good fun! Homework on paper and newsletter on paper, parents meeting with all teachers - maths science altogether. Fayres at suitable times ie; weekends, maybe record class assemblies as they would be good to keep, more school outings, more big school productions and a drama club, children should wash their hands after lunch, the toilets are very smelly, not drinking enough water, improve hygiene in toilets. Lining up in the morning can be chaotic with parents in the line, please do not send Church emails. Would like to have detailed information about the subjects taught at the start of the year, not to mix year 1 and 2, children in some classes should have homework during weekends to help them learn more. Better communication between teachers and parents re homework etc, better communication on a day to day basis with teachers and parents. More activities for year 1, Fayre at weekends. : More teachers, to help children understand more, study more, need to be very strict about their homework, targets and progress in reading. Sometimes our children homework are in their bag every day, expecting more progress the way they are teaching and rules of St.luke's. Chocolate fountain, focussing to improve child's interests, please start a secondary school. Better communication some things need explaining a little better at the onset, use the school calendar for little school trips, parking, communication between teachers sometimes not so well informed.

Any other comments : You are doing a great job, reception staff are amazing, polite, friendly and professional, I am impressed with St.Luke's, I love this school very much, You are working hard carry on. Keep up the good work, teachers and office staff are very supportive, you are very good, need improvement on my sons handwriting, I think the website and email distribution lists work well. I am extremely happy with the school and how lovely the staff are, make the children more aware about personal hygiene.
