



St. Luke's Home Learning Support (Absence linked Covid and possible Lockdown measures) Autumn 2020

St. Luke's CE School recognises that some children may be missing school days due to Covid related reasons whether awaiting a test or self-isolating. In response to supporting their education, the school have adopted a 3-tiered response:

- Tier 1 – Child misses 2/3 days school while awaiting test results
- Tier 2 – Child and family are self-isolating for 10 days
- Tier 3 – Lock down resulting in school closures

The 3 tiers approach links to learning in school which can be accessed via our eSchools pages, as well as, the Oak Academy. The Oak Academy is a national on-line school which has been created by teachers through a government funded initiative. You are also free to use other resources that your child usually uses to support them. Class emails will not become active unless we enter a full lockdown or a class bubble is self-isolating. These will then only be active during school hours. During a full lockdown, work will be marked in line with our marking policy. Photos may be sent in of work.

Please note, that this does not apply to children that are unwell so please only complete if your child is well and able.

Tier 3 – Full Lockdown

A full timetable will be issued once government guidance is released as to how often and which children are in school.

All staff will support a full lockdown, teachers and teaching assistants will support learning and emotional wellbeing through weekly contact and guidance. Daily safeguarding support will also continue to be available.
