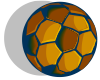


## Games and PE

Minnows and Tadpoles are a bubble, meaning that we can continue to work collaboratively and work in sets. This also means we have playtimes and lunch times together.

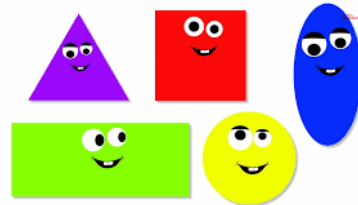
In school we sanitise our hands every time we enter or leave a room.

## Maths

The children will be learning to count numbers 1 to 10 and then move onto counting numbers to 20. We will also focus on recognising numbers 1 to 5/10. Additionally, the children will learn to recognise 2D shapes and talk about which shapes they can see in the environment.

## Literacy



Over the next two terms we will be looking at a range of books including both fiction non-fiction.

## Phonics

The children will be taught in phonics groups. We will be focusing on hearing different sounds and then the children will move onto recognising different letters. The internet is a very useful tool for supporting phonics, especially at home. We will send home words and letters to practise at home later in the term.
