Dear St Luke's Families,

To help with your child's home learning, please find attached your child's login details for Purple Mash. Purple Mash is an online learning platform that we use in school to complete Computing and Digital Literacy tasks.

As of next week, Teachers will set work, known as **2Dos**, for the children to complete online.


To see if a child has been set a **2Do** please follow these steps:

1. Logon using this link: www.purplemash.com/stlukessl6
2. At the top you will see a home bar



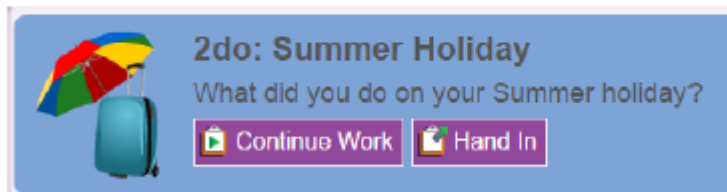
3. Click on the icon that says 2dos.
4. A list of activities to complete will appear.

To complete a 2Do follow these steps:

Step 1: Pupil should click on the  **Start** button. This will take them to the work that needs to be completed.

Step 2: Complete the work. When the pupil has completed the work, they should save it. This will save the work into a folder called 2dos for the Teacher to mark. Pupils can only see their completed assignments within the 2dos application.

Step 3: Once a pupil has saved their work, they can continue working on it or hand it in.



Pupils can add a typed comment and also an audio comment for the teacher when they click the

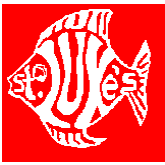

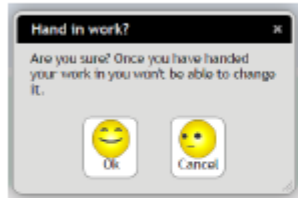


