Rehearsals are going well for our performances on Wednesday 10th July, and it is now time to think about costumes.

The following are suggestions of costumes for the cast – please look through them all in case you can offer an item to help someone else out.

Aladdin: boys clothing – waistcoat red/burgundy, $\frac{3}{4}$ length trousers, brown/beige cap.

Jasmin: young princess outfit – long flowing gown

Genie: brightly coloured outfit, turban. Possibly blue!

Abanazar: black/red outfit, long cloak. Looks like a villain!

Wantu (Abanazar's assistant): dark shorts, waistcoat, t-shirt, black/red

Widow Twankey: large dress with lots of frills, curly blonde wig, jewellery

Wishy and Washy: young boys outfit. Shorts, braces, name on T-shirt. Matching colours if possible.

Scheherazade: Queen/princess outfit – long flowing gown

King: Royal –purple, red, gold clothes, crown

Oracle: Mystical like a wizard

Matt and Wal Paint: Painter and decorator – white shirt, dungarees/trousers

Tom (Magic carpet): purple/yellow/gold top, waistcoat, brown trousers

DJ/MC: black smart shirt, tie and trousers

Sultan: brightly coloured outfit, turban

Sultan's servant: purple, red or blue – bright colours

Kings servants: black trousers, white shirt, coloured sash (scarf) tied around the waist

Maids: long dress, pinafore, mop hat

Wishes: Skirt and top or dress in bright blue

Gem 1: Ruby – red dress or skirt and top. Shiny if possible

Gem 2: Emerald – green dress or skirt and top. Shiny if possible

Gem 3: Gold - gold/yellow dress or skirt and top. Shiny if possible

Gem 4: Pearl – white dress or skirt and top. Shiny if possible

PC Bright and Crook: Police outfit – black trousers, white shirt. Extra “police” decoration/props if possible

Rat 1 and 2: Brown top and bottom, tail and ears

Mr Rick and Shaw: Smart shirt and trousers – any colours

Washing Line 1 and 2: Own clothes – any colours

Builder: Jeans and T-shirt, hard hat, builder props (high vis vest if possible)

Villagers: Headscarf for the girls, apron, long dress/skirt. Boys top, waistcoat, trousers tucked into long socks

Suitors: Smart, princely outfit
