Re: Year 1/2 Shepreth Wildlife Park visit

For our final topic of the year, Year 1 and 2 are learning about 'Amazing Animals'. As part of this, we have the exciting opportunity to visit Shepreth Wildlife Park on **Thursday 20th June 2019**. We will be looking at a variety of animal species, exploring their habitats, identifying their adaptations, as well as taking part in an interactive session with the Park Staff.

The trip is on **Thursday 20th June** and the **coach will be leaving at 9:30am**. The coach will **return to school at approximately 3:00pm**. The children will need to wear their school uniform, wear appropriate footwear and bring a waterproof coat in case of rain. **The children will need a packed lunch for the day. Please ensure no fizzy drinks or nuts.** If you would like to discuss this, do not hesitate to come and speak to us about it. Please ensure the children have a rucksack to carry their belongings.
