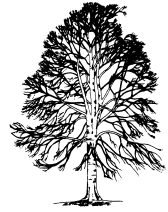

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2 SATs

Over the next few weeks, we will be preparing Year Two children for the Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). We will work through sample questions in an informal way and give them an opportunity to self-mark and ask any questions/ address any misconceptions. The children will continue to have homework to support their understanding.

Our aim is to prepare them as well as we can, but we will do our best to ensure that we do this without creating a sense of pressure or worry. The SATs week will take place from Friday 17th to Thursday 23rd May and during this period we will ensure that there is only one paper per day so that children have sufficient time and do them to the best of their ability.

There will be two reading papers and two maths papers (arithmetic and reasoning). The tests will be carried out in the classroom with the class teacher to maintain a sense of normality and comfort. The SATs tests are designed to inform the overall teacher assessment for each child rather than provide a definitive level.

Please ensure your child arrives at school at the normal time each day well-prepared, relaxed and with a good breakfast inside them!
