Dear Parents, Carers,

Sports Day

As you may be aware, each year we hold a school sports day. This year weather permitting, it will take place on Thursday 11TH July. The morning will consist of a rotation of sporting activities in which children from **Reception to Year 6** compete in their house groups.

For nursery, **this will be a normal nursery session for those usually attending.**

In a change to previous years, Nursery running races will take place **from 9:30am** on the running track that will be marked out at the side of the other activities.

If you would like to come and watch all of the events you would be very welcome to do so. If however you only wish to watch your nursery child compete, please be on the school field in good time for the first of our races at approximately 9:30am.

Please could we request that you do not approach your child while they are on the field and competing in the races as this can be very unsettling for all the children.

Immediately after nursery have completed their races, the children will return to Acorns Class for a drink and the remainder of their normal nursery session.

If you are staying for the whole sports day and you wish to collect your child before the end of the session please collect them via the school office after which, you will be responsible for their safeguarding. It would be appreciated if you could advise a member of the nursery staff if you wish to collect your child early.

Please ensure that your child comes to nursery on Friday 11th July dressed in suitable clothing for sports day i.e. tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts and a t-shirt or sweatshirt. **Please make sure they wear appropriate shoes to run in i.e. no 'Crocs', sandals or flip-flops please.** If it is a hot day they should have sun cream applied before arriving at school.
