Dear Parents, Carers,

Christmas is fast approaching and the children will soon be busy making some wonderful items to decorate our Christmas hoop, which will go on display in the school hall from the beginning of December. We have a number of activities and events to look forward to in the coming weeks, some of which are detailed below.

Christmas Play

On Monday 2nd December, Acorns Nursery Class will be performing in the YR1/FS Christmas Play, 'Hey Ewe!' Nursery children will **only** be in the morning performance which will start at 9:30am and last approximately an hour. Tickets for this performance are available exclusively for parents of nursery children and further information regarding how to obtain tickets will be sent via email from the school office.

The children will be playing the part of 'stars' in the production and will need a white/cream/light grey top/'t- shirt and white/cream/grey leggings/trousers/shorts or something similar for their costumes. Please do not provide tights or socks as they are too slippery for the stage and the children will be entering the hall in bare feet.

Please could the children bring their costume to school by Monday 25th November. Please ensure the costume is named and in a bag with your child's name on it.

Christmas Party

The Acorns Christmas party will be held during the morning session on Wednesday 18th December. **The party is open to all the children, even if they do not normally attend on a Wednesday.** The morning session time will be as normal 9am – 12pm. **Children who are at school all day should bring a packed lunch as usual.**

Nursery staff will organise prizes and food for the party but we would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of 50 pence from each child to help with costs. Please pass your contribution to a member of the nursery staff before Friday 6th December.

The children should come to school dressed in their Christmas Jumper but please bear in mind that we will be spending part of the session outside, as usual, so **please ensure your child has a coat and suitable shoes etc. for the weather.**

Please advise a member of staff if you know that your child **will not** be attending the party or **will not** be at nursery at any point during the last two weeks of term.
