Welcome back to Acorn's Class and a very Happy New Year to you all.

This term we will continue to focus on encouraging your child's independence in preparation for Reception Class, and supporting them in managing new experiences and changes in routine.

Parent Consultations - We will be holding parent consultations after school on Monday 11th and Wednesday 13th of February. Further details will be sent via school email and you will be able to book your appointment online.

PE - As part of our weekly PE lesson we will be introducing the children to the idea of changing for PE. To begin with we will support the children in taking off and putting on their socks and shoes independently. We would encourage you to support your child's independence at home too by giving them opportunities to dress and undress independently with simple items of clothing such as pyjamas.



Cooking - On Tuesday mornings after half term we will be introducing our weekly cooking activity. Further details will follow in due course.

Assemblies - This term Acorns Class will be joining older children in the school hall to attend FS/KS1 assemblies on a Thursday morning.
