HISTORY OFF THE PAGE DAY

Our topic is entitled 'Party Like a Roman' and as a part of that, our history work is going to focus on what life was like for a Roman. We have arranged for History Off the Page to spend the day with us on **Friday, 7th December 2018**, running a themed workshop providing the children with a fantastic opportunity to find out about what life was like in Roman Britain.

On this day, the children will be able to explore and handle artefacts, personal belongings and the sort of equipment that would have been typically found in a Roman villa of the period. They will then be involved in role-play, where they will be taking on the various roles of the villa inhabitants. In the afternoon, the children will be taking part in a Roman 'feast'.
