

## English

Friend or Foe and Carrie's War —historical fiction—class novel.  
Genres of writing to be covered include:  
Setting description, diary entry, recount, explanation, instructions, non-chronological reports, persuasive text, discussion, letters biographical and autobiographical, newspaper, narrative, debate.  
Speaking and listening —opinions, attitudes, opposing points of view, debating, evaluation of others opinions.  
Reading variety of genre making use of literal comprehension skills, inference, deduction, skimming, scanning. Analysis of reading text focusing on SATs style questions. Group reading, individual reading, shared reading. Writing across all genre of text as above.  
Grammar objectives: Revision of word classes. Recognising and using subjunctive and modal verb forms. Understanding synonyms and antonyms. Using relative clauses.

## Maths

Position and direction: describe positions on the full co-ordinate grid, draw, translate and reflect simple shapes.

The human body:

- The human body — stages of life, functions of the heart and lungs. Staying healthy—focus on healthy eating and physical exercise.

Living things and their habitats:

- Classification of living things — plants, animals into groups. Research to investigate vertebrates/invertebrates. Classification of vertebrates/invertebrates according to size, habitat, appearance, diet and other features.
