1. Summary

Outcomes for leavers are outstanding because:

- All Year 14 pupils received at least an Entry Level qualification in English, Mathematics and Life & Living.
- More able pupils leave with GCSE qualifications. This year, 7 pupils received between one and four GCSEs, graded from D to G.
- Pupils leave with qualifications across the curriculum.
- 47% of Year 14 pupils achieved a Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award.
- 67% of pupils following the employability pathway achieved job specific qualifications.
- 83% of pupils following the employability pathway completed an internal internship
- 42% of pupils following the employability pathway completed an external internship.
- 63% of pupils following the personal pathway achieved a Diploma in Life and Living.
- 100% of pupils following the personal pathway complete a work experience.
- 86% of pupils following the personal pathway achieved a level 1 Bike Ability qualification. 50% of pupils following the employability pathway achieved a level 1 Bike Ability qualification and 17% achieved a level 2 Bike Ability qualification.

- Of the Year 11 cohort, consisting of 13 pupils, there were no NEET pupils.
- 18 of 19 leavers went into full time education. 1 leaver went into full time employment.
- In Tracking the 2016 leavers, 10 of 15 continued in education. 2 leavers have moved onto full time employment and 2 have moved onto apprenticeships.

- Tracking of Leavers suggests the school equips them for life beyond Slated Row.

Annual qualifications show that:

- 5 Year 11 pupils sat GCSE Science with a 100% pass rate overall (D to G grades).
- 98 Entry Level qualifications were taken in a range of subjects, with a 100% pass rate.
- 6 pupils achieved a Step Up To English qualification, 4 a Gold Award & 2 Silver Awards.
- In Mathematics, 2 pupils achieved an Entry Level 1 Certificate, 2 achieved an Entry 2 Certificate and 5 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. Of the pupils taking Science, 2 achieved an Entry 1, 3 achieved an Entry 2 and 4 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. In Citizenship, 15 of the 29 pupils achieved an Entry Level 2 and 14 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. In Art, 16 pupils achieved an Entry Level Certificate, 12 at Entry 2 and 4 at Entry 3. RE had 3 pupils achieve an Entry Level 2 Certificate and 1 pupil achieve an Entry Level 3 Certificate.

- In Personal Progress (Personal Pathway KS4), all 8 pupils achieved a certificate at Entry Level 1.
- 17 pupils took Life and Living Entry Level (Sixth Form). 1 achieved an Introductory Award at level 2 and 1 achieved an Introductory Award at level 3. 6 pupils achieved a certificate at Entry Level 2 and 2 achieved a certificate at Entry Level 3. 1 pupil achieved an Entry Level Extended Certificate and 6 pupils achieved a Diploma at Entry Level 1.

2. Introduction

Pupils examinations are based on prior starting points or in the case of the sixth form other completed courses. The range of qualifications is linked to the curriculum, where key aspects are taken by all pupils, as well as an option element to the curriculum.

Progress is measured for pupils in Key Stage 4 using the school's own levels and tracking, including across Key Stage 3 and 4. This has also been completed for pupils in the Sixth Form for continuity in the school. See Pupil Outcomes Report on Progress & Attainment for more details.

3. Qualifications

Commentary of Annual Qualifications

Five Year 11 pupils sat GCSE Science with a 100% pass rate overall (Data table 1), the grades achieved were two Gs, two Fs and a D grade. The D grade was only 38 marks from a C grade.

98 Entry Level qualifications were taken in a range of subjects, with a 100% pass rate (Data table 2).

All six pupils entered achieved a Step Up To English qualification, which is a transitional qualification aimed at progression towards a GCSE. Four achieved a Gold Award (equivalent to Entry Level 3 qualification with additional outcomes above an Entry 3 towards a GCSE). Two pupils achieved a Silver Award (Entry 2).

In Mathematics, Science and Personal Progress, due to a clerical error, Certificates are pending in March 2018. The work has been moderated and the school is secure that these levels will be awarded. In Mathematics of nine pupils entered, 2 achieved an Entry Level 1 Certificate, 2 achieved an Entry 2 Certificate and 5 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. Of the pupils taking Science, 2 achieved an Entry 1, 3 achieved an Entry 2 and 4 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. In Citizenship, for which a number of pupils took the qualification early (in Year 10), 15 of the 29 pupils achieved an Entry Level 2 and 14 achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate. Art, an options subject including some sixth form pupils, had 16 pupils achieve an Entry Level Certificate, 12 at Entry 2 and 4 at Entry 3. RE, an option including sixth form pupils, had 3 pupils achieve an Entry Level 2 Certificate and 1 pupil achieved an Entry Level 3 Certificate.

In Personal Progress (Personal Pathway KS4), all 8 pupils achieved a certificate at Entry Level 1.

17 pupils took Life and Living Entry Level (Sixth Form). 1 achieved an Introductory Award at level 2 and 1 achieved an Introductory Award at level 3. 6 pupils achieved a certificate at Entry Level 2 and 2 achieved a certificate at Entry Level 3. 1 pupil achieved an Entry Level Extended Certificate and 6 pupils achieved a Diploma at Entry Level 1.

Other Awards

9 pupils followed the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, all of whom achieved a Bronze Award (Data table 3) 29 pupils achieved the Trinity Arts Awards, (Data table 4). 2 sixth form pupils achieved a level 1 certificate in The Laser hairdressing qualification (Data table 5).

4. Leavers

Achievements (Data table 6)

Sixth Form

All Year 14 pupils received at least an Entry Level qualification in English, Mathematics and Life & Living. All except two received a Science qualification (one a late starter, the other could not access the level of content), 79% received a qualification in Humanities. 68% achieved a ICT qualification and 95% left with an Art qualification.

1 pupil left with 4 GCSEs (3x F, 1x G grade); 1 pupil left with 3 GCSEs (E, F G grades); 1 pupil left with one F grade and one G grade GCSE, and 4 pupils left with 1 GCSE (a D & F grades).

47% of Year 14 pupils achieved a Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award; 6 in the personal pathway and 3 in the employability pathway.

100% of the pupils following the employability pathway achieved a Life and Living qualification, under employability looking specifically at the world of work through the following units: Health & Safety at Work, Preparation For Work, Getting Ready For Starting Work And Rights And Responsibilities At Work.

67% of pupils following the employability pathway achieved job specific qualifications, including, Food Hygiene Level 2, Sports Leader Level 1 and Hairdressing Level 1. With one pupil achieving safeguarding Level 1, Climbing instruction Level 1, 3 day First aid qualification, British cycling coaching award and Kayaking instructor; all of which supported the pupil in achieving full time employability at an Outdoor Bound Activity Centre.

83% of pupils following the employability pathway completed an internal internship with administration, Site, Kitchen or ICT teams at SRS. 42% of pupils following the employability pathway completed an external internship at BSH. Only 1 pupil following the employability pathway was unable to complete a work experience due to his high levels of anxiety.

100% of the pupils following the personal pathway achieved a Life and Living qualification looking specifically at personal skills such as travelling in the community, using and identifying community facilities, house hold tasks, cooking, managing money and travelling within the community.

63% of pupils following the personal pathway achieved a Diploma in Life and Living. 38% of pupils following the personal pathway achieved Functional Maths and English qualification.

100% of pupils following the personal pathway complete a work experience in production line work, packing, cleaning and labelling parts for external businesses.

86% of pupils following the personal pathway achieved a level 1 Bike Ability qualification. 50% of pupils following the employability pathway achieved a level 1 Bike Ability qualification and 17% achieved a level 2 Bike Ability qualification.

Key Stage 4

There was one leaver from Year 11 to join a school for pupils with more severe learning needs. They achieved a Trinity Arts Award. Following a massive regression in health and mental capacity, he was unable to access the qualifications.

Note: Key Stage 4 pupils are accounted for in the school's report on progress and achievement, using the school levels. This shows outstanding progress for the year and over time, from the end of Year 6 to the end of Year 11.

Destinations and retention (Data table 7)

Of the Year 11 cohort, consisting of 13 pupils, there were no NEET pupils and all but one remained at Slated Row for post 16 education, while moved to the school catering for more complex needs.

Data Table 6 shows that 18 leavers continued onto full time education, 17 at MK College and 1 leaver to Moulton College. 1 leaver went into full time employment at Coldecotte Outdoor Centre, following on a successful internship.

Data Table 7 shows that of the 2016 leavers, 9 of 15 continued in education at MK College. 1 leavers is still attending Harrogate Army College. 2 have moved onto full time employment. 2 leavers have moved onto apprenticeships after one year in College.

5. Identified areas for further development

- Introduce new qualifications for pupils to achieve and deliver BTEC level 1 qualification.
- Increased opportunities for pupils to engage in accredited courses for the work place, (e.g. LASER, Food Hygiene).
- Continue to further develop the Slated Row School tracking system in order to ensure that our provision continues to effectively prepare the pupils for life beyond education.
