Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and is recommended by PTA-UK. Since its inception in 2001 it has paid out more than £16 million. As well as raising vitally needed funds for our school, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. Bag2School will recycle adults' and children's clothes, shoes (tied together please), hats, belts, bags, soft toys, curtains and bedding (not duvets or pillows) and will give William Westley **£500 per tonne or £0.50/kg**. Children will bring home a donation bag today. There are more available in the School Office or you can use any other bags to donate your items. Bag2School will be collecting from our school on **Monday 25th November 2019 at 9.00am**.
