Nature of support 2015/2016

To ensure that Gaps are narrowed between those eligible for the Pupil Premium and other children we intend to spend the allocation as follows:

- 46% Additional Specialist Teacher to provide support for small groups or individuals who were identified for additional input.
- 9% Individual support for children so that they could access wider aspects of the curriculum, eg, swimming and educational visits.
- 3% Additional Teacher for individual support.
- 35% Additional Pupil Premium Intervention Worker for summer term, working with individuals and groups.
- 7% Additional support provided by Teaching Assistants.

This will ensure that the majority of children in receipt of PPG will either achieve or exceed national expectations.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2015/16

A Pupil Premium Intervention Worker will be employed for the summer term to focus on developing skills with the children. Individual interviews will be held and 'pupil passports' will be written in order to record their past progress and future targets.

TA support is targeted for those PPG children who needed additional support with reading and writing skills across the school.

12 children will be supported with funding to enable them to access other areas of the curriculum, eg, educational visits.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2016/17

Support needs identified and intervention workers appointed to meet the needs

Supporting educational trips and class visits.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

Progress will be measured throughout the year in pupil progress meetings and data analysis by SLT will be looked at closely by Governors. This report will then be updated accordingly.
