## Childhood Flu Vaccination

The school-based nasal flu vaccination programme helps protect your child against flu. Flu can be a dangerous illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Your child is entitled to the vaccination free, from the NHS.

You should have received information and a link to an electronic consent via your school's email. Your child has missed the vaccination at school, either because we didn't receive a response, or your child was absent, unwell or they declined the vaccination on the day.

**If you would still like your child to receive the vaccination, we are offering community clinics. Booking is essential. Call the number below to book onto a clinic, please only call between 9.00am – 4.30pm Monday to Friday.**
