The staff and I were very disappointed in the lack of attendance, particularly as this meeting was instigated following feedback from parental questionnaires completed earlier in the year and the fact that this meeting was advertised several times on the school newsletter. Some parents/carers had expressed concern over the way in which the school handles bullying and had requested more clarity over the approach Bury School takes towards dealing with the issue. Staff, Governors and the parents who did attend all felt that the session was very useful and confirmed to them that the school is working hard to prevent and deal with any bullying issues which may occur. Staff training and parent sessions like this reinforce the school's effective management of bullying. As a result of these training sessions, I can also confirm that the current Anti-Bullying Policy and Behaviour Policy will be updated.
