Attendance:



Following instruction from the Education Welfare Officer (EWO), we ask parents to please ensure that, should their child be absent from school for any medical reason, they provide a **specific** reason for their absence, e.g. tonsillitis, chickenpox etc. Advising the school that the child is simply 'unwell' or 'poorly' will result in the child receiving an unauthorised mark on their attendance record. The EWO looks at all unauthorised absences and will investigate further any child's attendance which drops below 90%.

Social Media:



Following various concerns over social media use outside of school, we would like to urge you to be vigilant and pay attention to the various different forms of social media your children may be using. There are age restrictions on most social media applications and primary school aged children are advised not to access them at all.
