A reminder that meals for KS2 children are £2.25 per day and should be paid for on the day or in advance. Payments can currently be made by cash or cheque (payable to Bury Primary School).

We also have use of a payment system called Pupil Asset, though unfortunately there are currently technical issues with this. Pupil Asset can usually be accessed via an app or online (https://www.pupilasset.com/). Your username should be your email address (as provided to the school) and if it's your first time logging in you can create your own password. Pupil Asset have advised that there may be issues with using the app on Apple devices at the minute but it should be accessible on Android devices provided that the app is the most current version. They are working on all issues with the payment system and we will keep you updated as necessary. Thank you for your patience.

School Uniform:



May we refer you to the school uniform section on the school website (Parents – School Uniform) and ask that you please adhere to this. Specifically, footwear should be sensible dark coloured shoes or black trainers (separate trainers/plimsolls should be in school for PE lessons).
