Please can we remind you and your children that the Posts section on Teams should only be used to discuss school work and not for general chat. The thread fills up quickly and work questions and answers can get lost amongst discussions. Please use Purple Mash to email your child's teacher for any other queries – or send an email to the office to be passed on.

Please ask your child not to start a new 'meeting' on their class Team – this effectively means that the child is 'hosting' the meeting and the teacher cannot share their screen to enable them to teach. They should **never** be clicking 'Meet' at the top of the screen as the teacher will open the meeting at the allotted time and then children can join.

You must email the office for attendance/illness/medical notifications and not the class teacher.

School meals new payment system - SchoolGrid:



Our new meal booking/payment system, SchoolGrid, goes live on Monday (18th January). You should have received an email on Thursday with log in details to enable you to set up your account. Please do this as soon as possible, even if your child is not currently in school.

Please ensure you place your food orders by 8.55am on Monday if your child is in school next week and would like a hot meal – a reminder that you can pre-order meals in advance e.g. a week at a time or even half termly.
