Dear Parents/Carers,

You will have received an email yesterday notifying you of positive cases of Covid-19 reported in school this week which has resulted in two classes having to self-isolate. As we are doing everything we possibly can within school to limit contact between classes, I would like to ask you to support us in this by avoiding unnecessary mixing and maintaining social distance outside of school. I know this is a difficult time for everyone and although Government guidance does allow people to go to the park and mix outside, as I'm sure you can imagine, it is extremely frustrating to see bubbles mixing outside of school. It is important to note that this would make it very difficult for us to quickly identify which children may need to isolate if we were notified of another positive case.

It has been brought to my attention that some children who have been told to isolate have been playing with others outside or going for walks. I must advise you that the self-isolation period is different to lockdown and therefore those children that are isolating **MUST** remain at home during this time. This means, they cannot leave their house/garden to go to the shop, for exercise or any other reason.

Please remain vigilant with regards to identifying symptoms of coronavirus and ensure that if you or your children develop symptoms you isolate immediately and book a PCR test. Please note that Lateral Flow Tests are not to be used if you have symptoms. If any member of the household shows symptoms and is tested, all members of the household should remain at home whilst waiting for the results. We would ask that you inform school immediately if anyone in your household develops symptoms.

We are pleased to let you know that Mrs Coulston will return to school in September. She will be working three days a week.

### Parking at front of school – yellow lines:

As the weather is looking changeable on Monday, we will let you know by text if your child's sports day slot has had to be cancelled or changed. For those children who are self-isolating, we will be setting sports activities for the day.

### Grafham residential:

### Monday 19<sup>th</sup>/Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> September:



There will be no PE on the last two days of school and so children should come into school in normal uniform.

### Reading books:



Please ensure all school reading books (including AR books) are returned to school by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

### September arrangements:



School gates (side and rear) will be opened at 8.40am for Key Stage 2 children to enter the school site where they will go to the playground to line up. Reception children should enter through the side gate and Year 1 and Year 2 children should enter through the front doors (teachers will be at the doors to greet them) at **8.45am**. Year 6 children will go straight through to their classroom at 8.40am to get ready for Reception buddies (providing Government guidance allows this). Year 3, 4 and 5 will go into class at 8.45am. Gates will be closed by 8.50am. We would ask where possible that Key Stage 2 children enter and leave school through the back gate. We will continue with the one-way system at the front of the school, please walk down the driveway and back up the school path.

School will finish at **3.15pm**. Key Stage 2 children will leave through the back gate (unless you have requested for them to leave via the front). Reception children will leave through the side gate and Years 1 and 2 will leave through the doors at the front of school.

We will advise you of PE days when we return in September but please note that children should come to school in normal uniform for the first two days back.

We will not be inviting parents/carers to Celebration Assemblies until October at the earliest.
