### Join the junior parkrun family!

Children run, jog or walk against the clock to try and beat their personal best time and in doing so have fun while getting fitter and making friends in the fresh air. Adults are welcome to join in with their children (although they won't receive a time). Importantly, you don't need to be able to run the whole 2km to take part and everyone is welcome.

Please arrive by 8.45am, ready to run at 9am.
