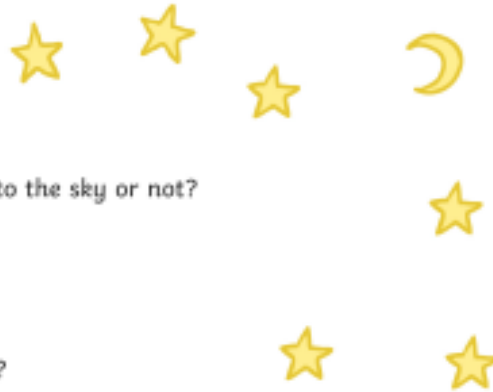
Write a story using this title: The day the stars fell.

- Have you written in first or third person?



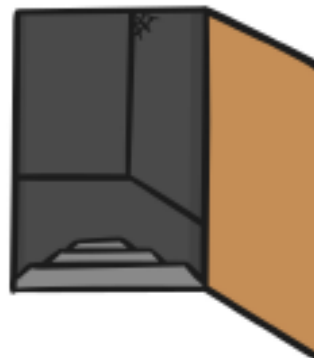
Write a story using this as the first sentence: I crept carefully into the cellar and realised that there was something down there, waiting for me.
