# Reception - Remote Learning

MARCH 2021

## What is remote learning?

Due to the Coronavirus, children may have to miss school while they isolate or due to lockdowns. This may be for a couple of days if they are waiting for test results or ten days if a member of their household has had a positive test or longer in the case of a lockdown. Remote learning is learning from home when you cannot be at school because of Covid-19.

## What will remote learning look like?

You can access the remote learning activities using your 'Evidence Me' account on the app.



Here you'll find a lot of useful web links as well as activities to complete with your child.

Click on the current week's home learning timetable to see the activities for the week and then click on the individual activities to view or download them.

## Which activities does my child need to do and when?

Each week we will provide you with our school timetable so you can get an idea of what we would normally do in school and when.

Where possible, each day we would like you to share a book for 10 minutes as well as one of our daily challenges. There will be other 'busy learning' jobs linked to different areas of the curriculum such as 'Knowledge and Understanding of the World', 'Expressive Art and Design' which you can choose when to complete.

## Reading

Read or share a book with your child for at least 10 minutes. If you do not have any reading books at home then click on the link for Oxford Owls or Collins e-books on the 'Evidence Me' app.

## Maths

At school we plan our lessons based on a scheme called 'White Rose'. On your weekly timetable you will find some maths challenges for the week.

## English

We have English lessons linked to a quality text each week or fortnight at school. You will find possible web links to the books and sometimes PowerPoints on the 'Evidence Me' app.

## Phonics

We will upload our lesson Power Points and activities. We have four phonics lessons a week normally, where we introduce three new sounds and one set of new words. These words and sounds will be highlighted on your weekly

timetable. Your child can also click on the Phonics Play link with the app for some fun games.

### **What if the full amount of work provided cannot be completed every day?**

The expectation is that we provide a full curriculum and have regular contact with families supporting children to learn. We understand that sometimes family members may be unwell, working from home, or for other reasons it may not be possible to complete all remote learning provided. Please let us know if you or your child are struggling to engage with remote learning so we can best support you and your family.

### **Who will see the work?**

You can send us photos and videos of your child's work by attaching them to a parent postcard with your 'Evidence Me' app. Teachers will be able to look at these and respond with comments and suggestions.

IMPORTANT INFO: Once an observation has been posted by a teacher please create a parent postcard if you wish to share a comment to your child's teacher directly. **PLEASE DO NOT POST** directly under the observation as ALL reception parents and teachers can see these comments, and teachers are not alerted to these so may miss a query or great work from your child.

### **What if my child gets stuck on work or does not understand work provided?**

The teachers will all still be here (providing we are well) so email us a message using the reception email address and we'll get back to you as soon as we can, during working hours.

### **What if I would like more activities?**

There are lots of links on the home page you could try for even more activities for your child.

### **What if I can't print the activities?**

and request a printed work pack, but you will need someone who is not isolating to collect it for you as soon as possible. These packs do take time to prepare so we would appreciate it if you only request one if you can't print and if you are able to have it collected. Please note the majority of the activities are designed to be interactive and play based and writing could be in a note book, white board, colourful paper we don't mind.

## What if my child's bubble is closed?

If the whole bubble is sent home to isolate then we will continue to send work via the 'Evidence Me' app. More details will be provided at the time if this were to happen.
