Headteacher's notes...

We started this week in our Assembly thinking about teams, as Euro 2020 had just started. We looked at what this means in our school and how everything we do affects each other. Our staff work as a fantastic team supporting the children each day and there are so many great examples of how the children also work together which we celebrate regularly.

This week we saw some teamwork in action as children across KS2 took part in the Young Voices 'Biggest Sing' in an attempt to break a world record – we are still waiting to hear the outcome! A team from Year 5 competed in the County Maths Challenge and last night children from Year 6 represented the school in the Rotary Quiz, coming 5th overall. Well done to everyone involved.



Next week children from Year 6 will be going on their residential visit to Laches Wood. We hope that they have a successful trip and are lucky with the weather. Daily updates will be available from the front page of the school website.

As part of being in our local community it is important that we help and support each other and that has been really evident during the past few months. Donations to the Foodbank are always much appreciated and they will be collected again by the 15th July. The baskets are in the main reception area – thank you.

Following guidance released this week and advice from the Local Authority we will continue to follow our covid risk assessment. Unfortunately, this means that we are not planning to hold any events with parents coming into school.
