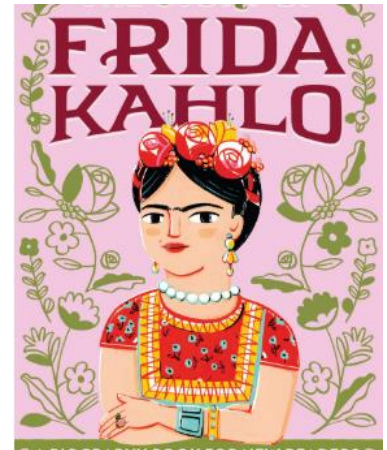


# Kahlo Class
