In order that we are all prepared in the case of a possible closure of a class due to Covid we have created a class folder on our school website in the area " Our Learning - self isolation". Within this section there are Learning grids for both KS1 and KS2 as well as suggested websites and learning activities for each class. We will also be teaching children online using Zoom. Please let us know if your child requires support with an electrical device in order to access our Zoom learning. Your child will be bringing home with them materials to support them should we need to close a class, however, I would like to stress that these materials should only be used if we have to close therefore please keep them in a safe place and we will contact you if it becomes necessary. If the teacher is unwell and cannot teach the class we will use the Self Isolation grids in each Class' page on the website. These grids will provide a comprehensive package of 10 days learning which your child can access on a tablet, phone or laptop. There are grids for each year group with links to all the materials that your child will need.
