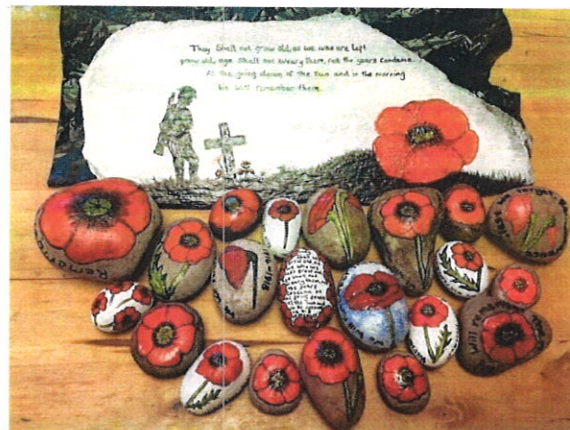
Free School Meals
