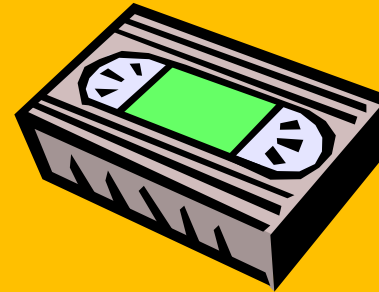

# Accelerated Reader

This is a reading programme we launched across KS2 three years ago. All children in year 5 will follow the programme. Each child will do an on-line test four times a year to assess their reading comprehension. They will then read books within a certain level and do a quiz on the book once they've finished reading it. Even if the book seems a bit young for your child, remember that it is the **comprehension** of the book they are quizzed on, not how well they can read the words.

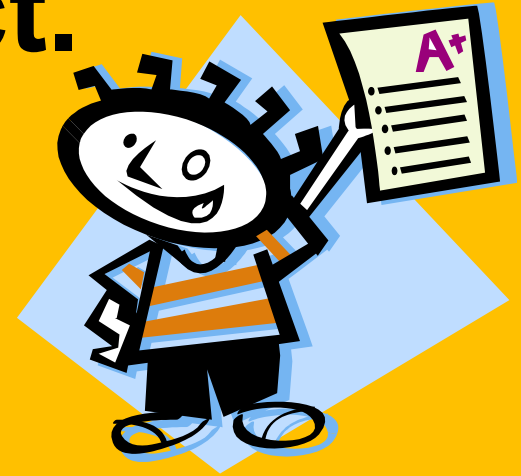

# How you can support your child

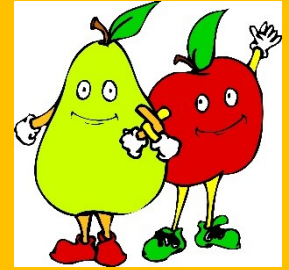
