School Uniform.

At Seaford Primary School uniform is worn by all our children and encourages a sense of pride and belonging in their school. Please could we kindly ask you to ensure that the children are wearing the correct uniform and that this is clearly named in order to help us successfully return any lost property to the right children.

Our school uniform is:-

Grey trousers/shorts/pinafores/skirts

Dark green sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan

White shirts/blouses/polo shirts

White/grey/green socks or tights

Green and White check/stripe dress (for summer)

Sensible black school shoes (with backs and low heels). Sensible white or dark coloured sandals in the summer.

Please note boots, trainers or flip flops are not appropriate. Wellingtons or boots may be worn to school on cold/wet days but a change of footwear should please be sent in for wearing in class during the school day.

Please also remember, for reasons of safety and security, the children should not wear jewellery to school except for studs for children with pierced ears. Children should please also wear plain head bands and not novelty ones.

We are very grateful for your support in ensuring our children come to school looking smart and appropriately dressed. Thank you.
