Acceptable Internet User Agreement for Pupils (KS2)

I understand that these rules are in place to keep everyone safe and to help us to use the internet sensibly and appropriately.

I will use the internet appropriately:

- I will ask permission before using the internet and only use it when a teacher or responsible adult is with me.
- I will not use devices from home without permission.
- I will not download anything from the internet onto a school computer.
- I will only use the internet for school work unless given permission by my teacher to use an approved website.
- I will not use a personal e-mail account at school.
- I will not use internet chat or instant messaging at school.
- I will only print documents when a teacher or responsible adult has given permission.

I will use the internet safely:

- I will never give out mine or others' user name, password, personal details, home address or phone number either by e-mail or on the website.
- If I see anything on the internet that I am unhappy about or I receive messages I do not like I will tell my teacher immediately.
- I understand that the school will monitor and filter my use of the systems, devices and digital communications to keep me safe.
- I will not meet anyone that I have communicated with on the internet.

I will act as I expect others to act towards me:

- I will respect others' work and will not delete or alter this in any way.
- I will be polite and responsible when I communicate with others, I will not use strong, aggressive or inappropriate language and I appreciate that others may have different opinions.
- I will not take or distribute images of anyone without their permission.

I understand that if I deliberately break these rules I may not be allowed to use the internet or computers. I understand that the school also has the right to take action against me if I am involved in incidents of inappropriate behavior, that are covered in this agreement, when I am out of school and where they involve my membership of the school community.
