E-Safety

We are aware that some children from school are playing the online game Fortnite at Home. The game content is rated as suitable for school pupils above the age of 12 due to the violence the game contains. Parents should also be aware that with this game there is an online chat facility through which the children can talk to anyone else playing the game. This could potentially leave the children open to the threat of online bullying or grooming. While we do cover how to keep yourself safe as part of our computing curriculum in school, we would highly recommend reminding your children that they are safer if they only use this online chat facility to talk to other players they already know. An alternative to ensure your child's safety is to disable the online chat facility in the game.

It can be very difficult as a parent to keep up with the games that children want to play as they change so frequently. If you want to find out more about any online game the NSPCC has a really useful website Net Aware which gives a short review of each game and outlines any potential risks for users. It is well worth a look at.
