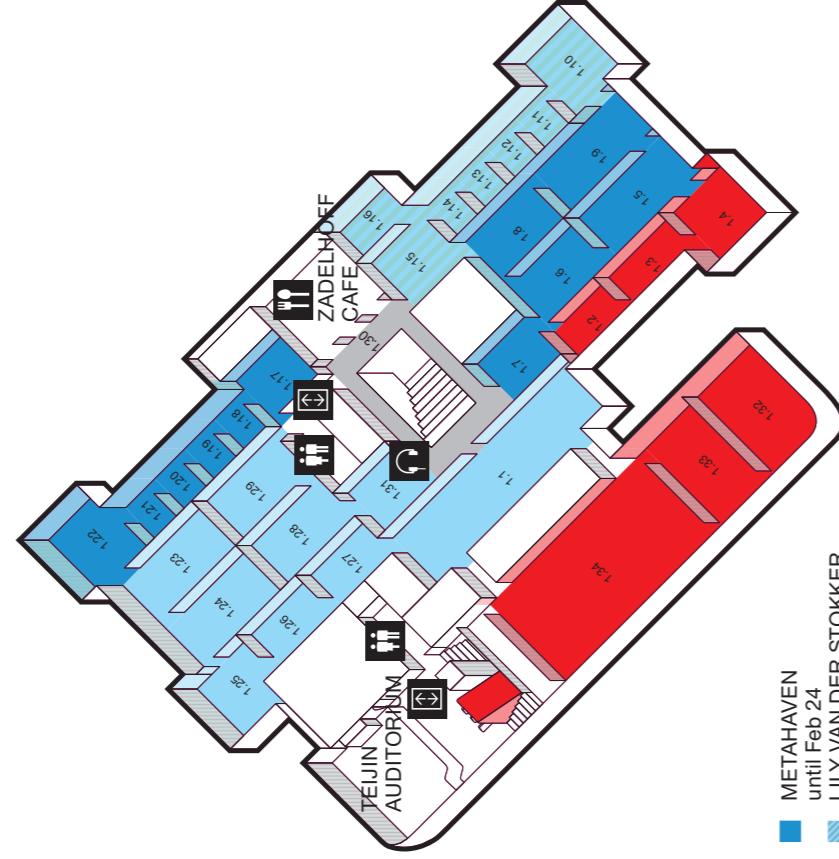


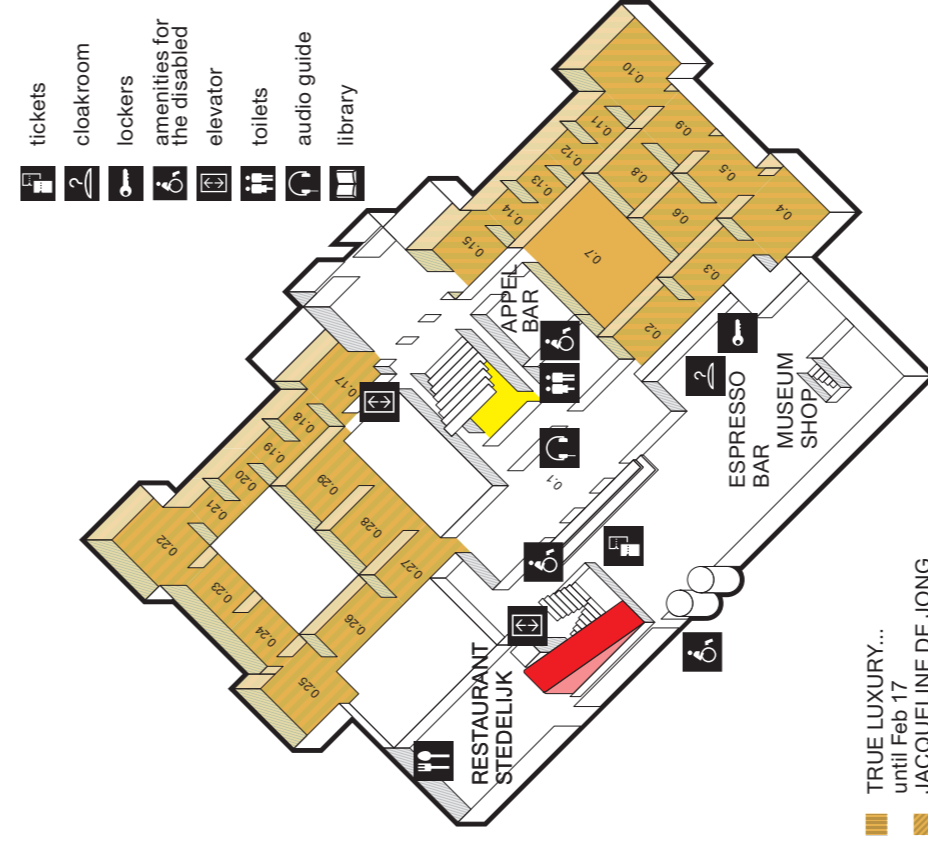

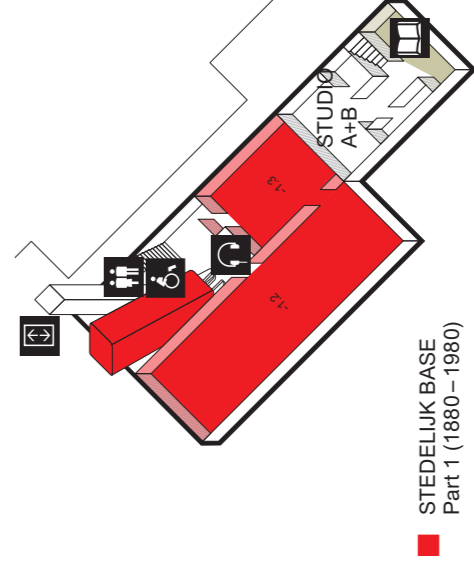

To celebrate the start of a new year, the Stedelijk Museum brings you a host of fresh, new voices. The Stedelijk always offers a platform for young artists and, this season, there's a lot of work by up-and-coming talent for you to admire. Discover the monumental paintings of Raquel van Haver, recently awarded the Dutch Royal Award for Modern Painting 2018, in *Spirits of the Soil*. Or be surprised by the time-based media art in *Freedom of Movement* – Municipal Art Acquisitions 2018, which is comprised of twenty works from a juried open call.

The museum is also showing work by prominent, established artists. *Pinball Wizard: The Work and Life of Jacqueline de Jong* gives an overview of the historical development of an oeuvre in which the artist switches effortlessly between different styles: from expressionist painting to new figuration and pop art. The exhibition features a selection of key works by De Jong and works from the Stedelijk collection, along with previously unseen archival material. -1 THE COLLECTION – STEDELIJK BASE

Part 1 (1880 – 1980)

STEDELIJK BASE is the permanent installation of highlights from the collection of the Stedelijk Museum. The presentation features a selection of almost 700 works of art, grouped around historic movements, social themes, and influential artists.

The installation begins on the lower-level floor, with art created before 1980. Take the escalator from floor -1 to floor 1, which hosts a display spotlighting the arts produced after 1980.

The display was specially designed by AMO / Rem Koolhaas with Federico Martelli. You are invited to create your own route, and the traditional room to room museum experience is transformed into a quasi-urban experience where every turn of a corner is a new discovery.

True Luxury... is a survey exhibition of works of art donated and purchased between 2012 and 2018. Among the show's highpoints is the space-filling installation by Erik van Lieshout, the imposing video installations of Arthur Jafa and the *AIDS Wallpaper* of General Idea.

JACQUELINE DE JONG – PINBALL WIZARD

opens Feb 9

An overview of the historical development of Jacqueline de Jong's oeuvre in which she switches effortlessly between different styles: from expressionist painting to new figuration and pop art. The scale also varies: small diptychs portraying a day in the life alternate with vast canvases in which an absurd, often violent and erotic world reigns.

TINO SEHGAL – THIS VARIATION

Feb 4–Mar 3

One of the most extensive and complex works from the oeuvre of Tino Sehgal will be re-enacted. During the year-long retrospective in 2015, this work was one of our visitors' favourite pieces. Recently acquired by the Stedelijk Museum, the work takes place in a completely darkened room.

RAQUEL VAN HAVER – SPIRITS OF THE SOIL

Van Haver produced a new series of paintings for this exhibition. She refers to her work as 'loud' paintings that sympathetically portray people on the fringes of society.

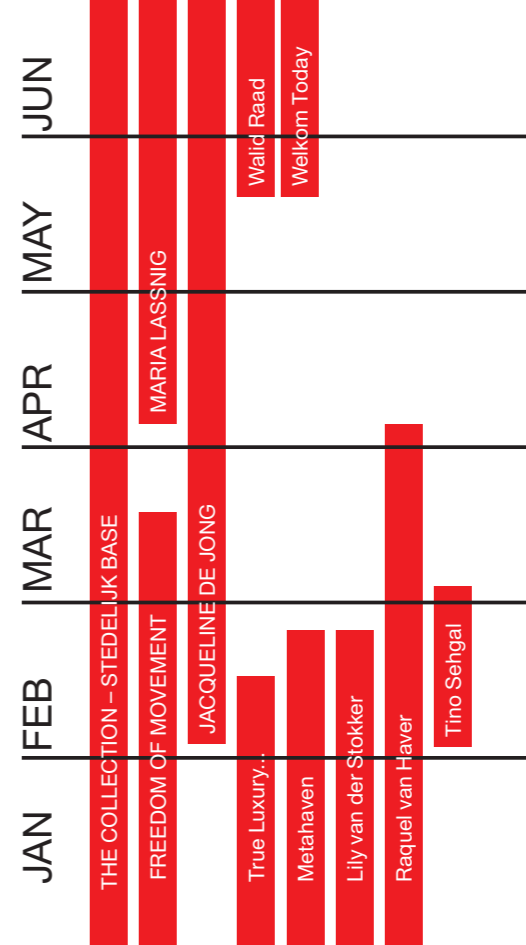
