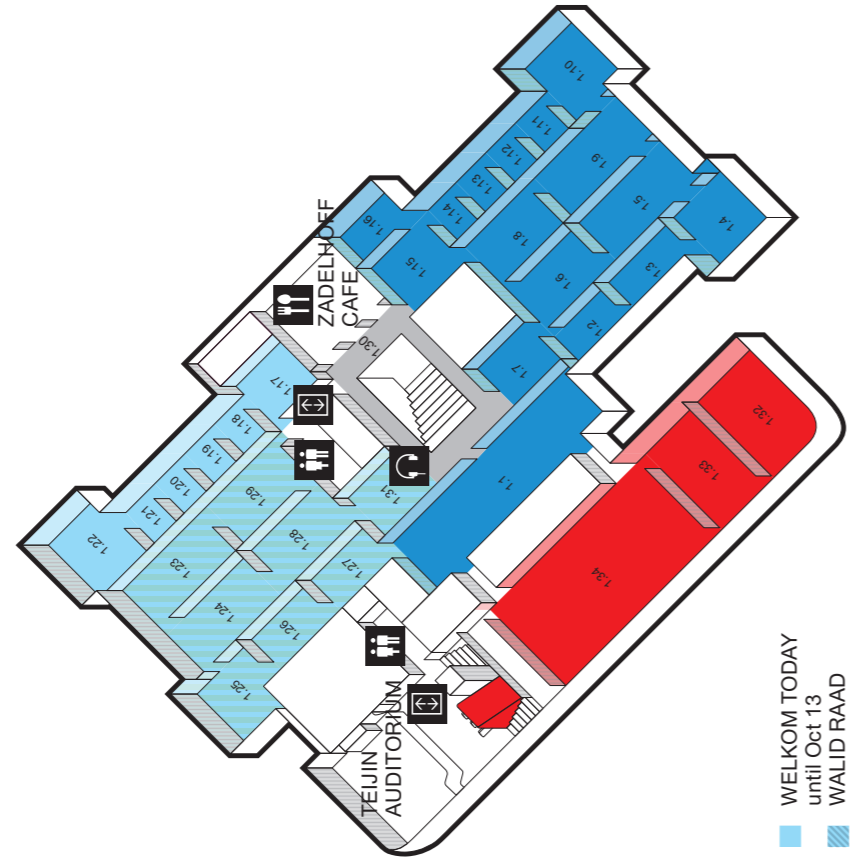


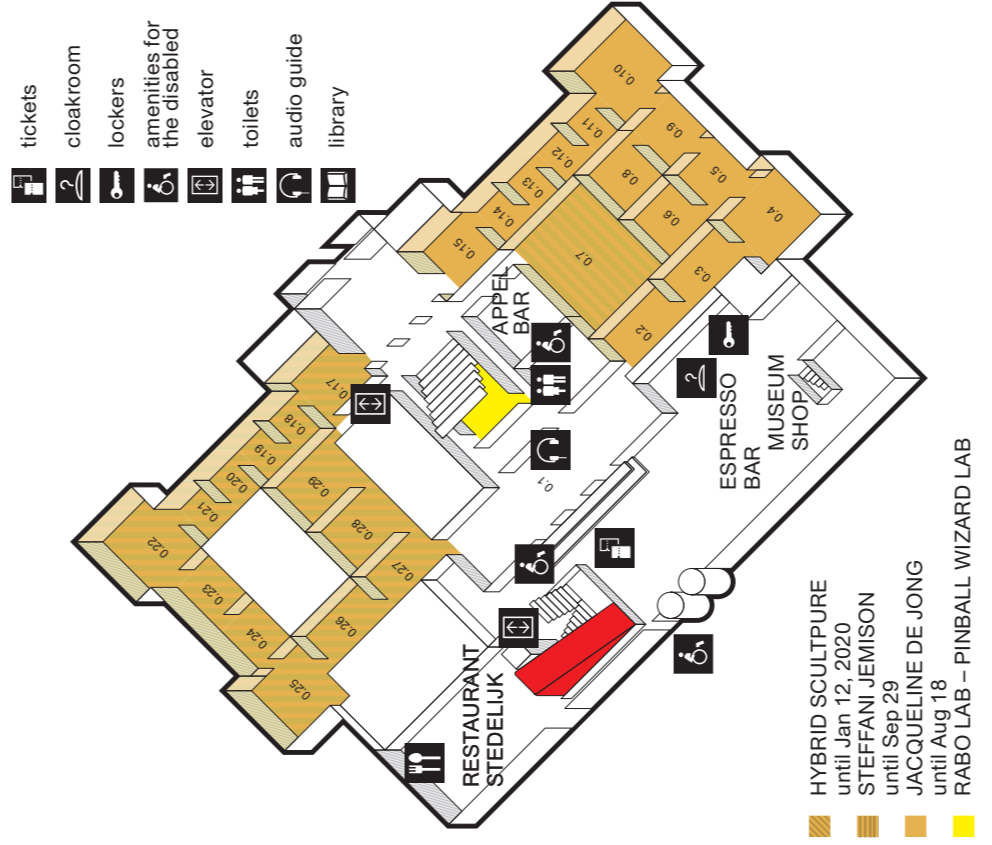

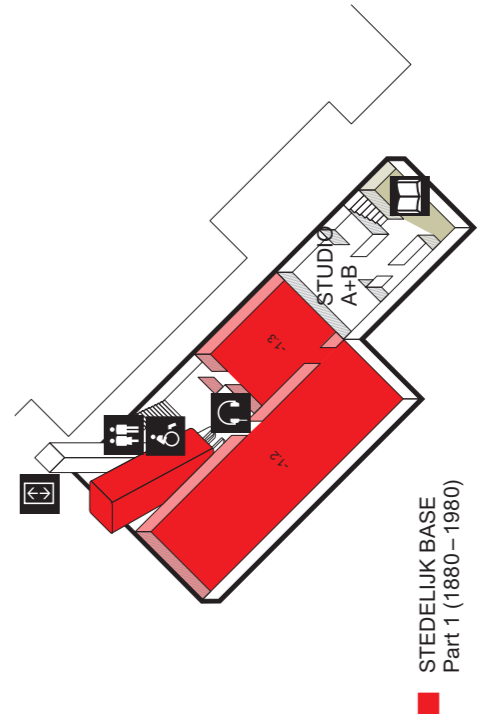

THE COLLECTION – STEDELIJK BASE

Part 1 (1880 – 1980) and Part 2 (1980 – now)

STEDELIJK BASE is the permanent installation of highlights from the collection of the Stedelijk Museum. The presentation features a selection of almost 700 works of art, grouped around historic movements, social themes, and influential artists. STEDELIJK BASE offers an entirely new experience of modern art and design, showcasing the Stedelijk icons in an innovative and bold presentation.

The first part of STEDELIJK BASE, with art created before 1980, begins on the lower-level floor (–1). The display was specially designed by AMO / Rem Koolhaas with Federico Martelli. Visitors are invited to create their own route, and the traditional room to room museum experience is transformed into a quasi-urban experience where every turn of a corner is a new discovery.

The second part of STEDELIJK BASE, with highlights from the collection created after 1980, can be found on the first floor.

JACQUELINE DE JONG – PINBALL WIZARD

until Aug 18

Overview of the historical development of the oeuvre of Jacqueline de Jong in which she switches effortlessly between different styles: from expressionist painting to new figuration and pop art.

HYBRID SCULPTURE

until Jan 12, 2020

Hybrid Sculpture presents a selection of work from the collection that reveals how radically sculpture has changed since 1990. The exhibition features more than twenty pieces by nineteen artists, most of them large-scale works.

STEFFANI JEMISON – NEW VIDEOS

until Sep 29

American artist Steffani Jemison presents two companion films in which she explores the role of language and gestures in creating meaning. *Sensus Plenior* (2017) is on view until August 2 and *Similitude* (2019), which has its world premiere at the Stedelijk in this presentation, is on view from August 3.

MARIA LASSNIG – WAYS OF BEING

until Aug 11

A retrospective of the Austrian artist Maria Lassnig, who is internationally regarded as one of the leading women artists of the 20th and 21st centuries and famous for her 'body awareness' paintings.

WALID RAAD

until Oct 13

In *Let's be honest, the weather helped* Raad presents his critical and often witty vision of the complexities of the Lebanese Civil War and developments in contemporary art in the Middle East.

WELKOM TODAY

until Oct 13

A multivocal photography exhibition about the post-apartheid era in South-Africa. With old and new photos by Ad van Denderen, Lebohang Tlali and young students, as well as photo albums, newspaper archives and family stories.

COLORFUL JAPAN

opens Sep 7

The Stedelijk presents 226 of its 800 Japanese posters. The selection represents a cross-section of designs that illustrate the breadth and dynamism of this portion of the graphic design collection.

BLIKOPENERS IN BASE

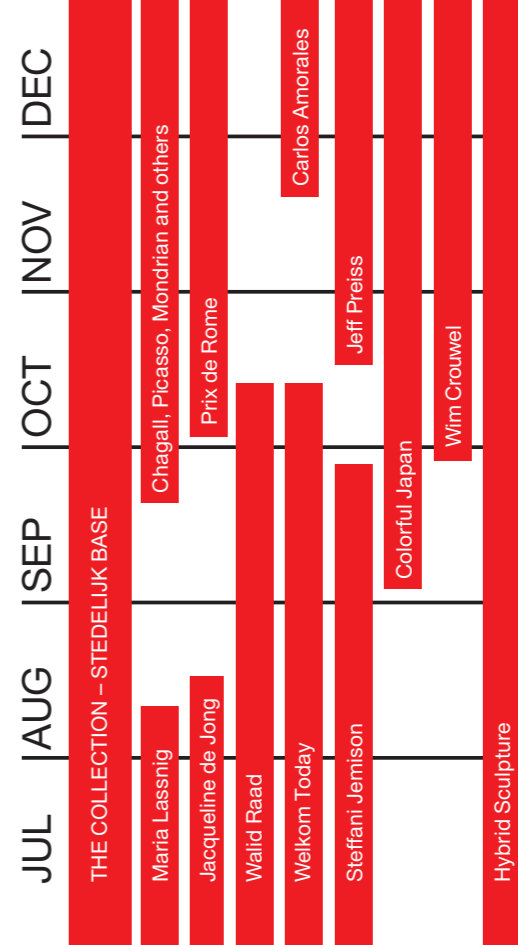
