## Scholastic Book Fair




Following a very successful Book Fair we are delighted to inform you that we sold books to the value of just over £1200.

## Primary Maths Challenge Bonus Round Results



We are delighted and really proud to announce that Stag Lane achieved the best results we've EVER had in the Primary Maths Challenge Bonus Round this year. Five of our children were invited to take part in this prestigious competition which was, in itself, a phenomenal achievement. Denisa (6L) was just short of a medal, Leo (5P) was awarded a Bronze medal, Kammesh (6PK) and Samiha (6C) both gained a Silver medal but Harish (6C) pipped them all to achieve GOLD! 68 000 children in Britain and beyond took part in the first round - including 100 Stag Lane students. 2696 children were invited to take the Bonus round. 167 children gained Gold medals in the Bonus round. Congratulations to them all. We can't wait to hear what they achieve in the future!
