Each half term, we set maths homework to reinforce number skills that help the children to become more successful in their learning. We ask that parents use the information below to support their child in practicing these valuable skills; parents can also find further support on the school website.

To provide appropriate challenge for children, we have provided three boxes below. "Safe" reinforces skills from the previous year, "stretch" is aimed at end of year expectations for the current year group and "super-stretch" pushes children to look at the year ahead of them!

### Safe

Objective 1:  
Solve problems with addition and subtraction: using concrete objects and pictorial representations.

Objective 2:  
Add and subtract nos using concrete objects and pictures involving 2 digits and ones.

Objective 3:  
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

### Stretch

Objective 1:  
Solve problems with addition and subtraction: using concrete objects and pictorial representations; applying their increasing knowledge of mental and written methods.

Objective 2:  
Add and subtract nos using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including: a 2-digit no and 1s or 10s; two 2-digit numbers; adding three 1-digit numbers.

Objective 3:  
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.

### Super Stretch

Objective 1:  
Solve problems with addition and subtraction: applying their increasing knowledge of mental and written methods.

Objective 2:  
Add and subtract nos mentally including: a 2-digit no and 1s or 10s; two 2-digit numbers; adding three 1-digit numbers and beginning to add 3 digit nos and ones.

Objective 3:  
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 3, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
