Objectives of a Learning Adventure

- Create inspirational and memorable moments.
- To provide enriched, fun, creative, relevant and challenging experiences.
- Create real purposes for learning.
- To provide opportunities for pupils to develop creativity and problem-solving in real life situations.
- Create a real outcome that is shared across the school community.
- Change our views of each other by shining a light on hidden skills!
- To help the pupils learn and reflect on the process of learning.
- To enable pupils to set their own learning targets and evaluate their own progress.
- Raise the profile of skills, subjects or themes.
- To provide opportunities for pupils to develop leadership skills, confidence, collaborative skills, independence and resilience.
- To promote links with the local and wider community.

Specific Objectives of this ACTIVE KIDS Learning Adventure

- Learn a range of playground games.
- Each child in the school to write about their favourite game
- Children take part in before and after evaluations to show how their skills have improved.
 - Before/Pre Task – children to pre-assess their playtime experiences, how active are they?
 - After/End of Week – children to reassess their skills and knowledge from the week.

Principles of a Learning Adventure

- We maintain a high standard of attainment & presentation.
 - We will focus on quality of learning.
 - We seek to provide enriching, creative and fun activities.
 - We ensure that learning is inclusive and accessible to all pupils.
 - The whole school focus will be introduced in an assembly at the outset and the children will evaluate their experience at the end of the week.
