Dear Families,

With the start of spring we can now see the blossoms on the trees beginning to emerge as well as spring bulbs and flowers sprouting to brighten our world. It is great to see some blue skies and sunshine - they make a great difference to break and lunchtimes!

This newsletter contains three very important messages for families...

FIRSTLY, we have entered a transitionary period where we move towards a more normal way of organising school life, less dominated by Covid 19 restrictions. We will of course keep a close eye on cases at the school and should we see a significant rise in cases we may need to bring back previous arrangements. This week, children across KS2 have begun to play all together outdoors on the playground as we return to a more normal timetable. Next week, we will be starting face to face assemblies with children in their phase groups to settle them into a new routine.

Covid 19 remains an issue for us all and we do need the support of families to ensure that any child who shows symptoms accesses a PCR test and self-isolates if they test positive. *Please see the details on page 2 for more information*.

SECONDLY, good news for our long awaited dining hall! The site has been set up by the contractor and works start on Monday 14th March starting with grounds work. I was told in a meeting earlier this week that the completion date for the project will be October. *Please see page 3 for more details*.

THIRDLY, on personal note, my wife is expecting a bay with the due date just after the Easter holiday. I will be taking my paternity leave immediately after the holiday followed by a short period of further leave so that I can be there to support my family. To ensure the school has consistency of senior leadership in the next half term, I am pleased to say that, in my absence, Mrs Dean will become the Acting Headteacher with Mrs McAndrew the Acting Deputy Headteacher; they will both be supported by Mrs Amui in her role as Assistant Headteacher. I will be returning to the school on Friday 27th May. I know the school will be safe in their very capable hands.

Finally, a reminder that we have been advised by Brent that our building will be used as a Polling Station for the local elections in May. <u>The school will be closed to children on Thurs 5th May.</u>


Isolation for Positive Cases

Although the legal obligation to isolate following a positive test result has been removed, it is still strongly recommended that individuals who test positive isolate for at least five days. The Government advises those who have tested positive to remain at home. Therefore, if your child tests positive for Covid-19, please keep them at home for at least five days and inform the school office of the reason for absence.

We will continue to keep a log of absences related to positive Covid-19 cases so that we can identify whether there are any potential outbreaks.

If your child shows any Covid-19 symptoms, however mild, please keep them at home and inform the school office of the reason for absence. You should book a test to check whether your child has Covid-19.

If your child displays symptoms whilst they are in school, we will continue to follow our procedure of using an isolation room and asking you to collect your child.




If your day 5 LFD test result is positive, you can continue taking LFD tests until you receive 2 consecutive negative test results.

Dining Hall Development...

Our new dining hall will be built in the same space as the old dining room but it will be very different! The school has contributed money towards the building project to ensure it meets our needs. We have paid additional money to add extra capacity to the dining hall space where the children will eat as well as adding a room specifically for our Breakfast Club and After School Club provision. This means we will also have additional space to run more after school clubs once the building has been completed.
