**OGPS CELEBRATES:** GREAT NEWS!


Our commitment to excellent provision in the arts has been recognised and we have been awarded Arts Mark GOLD! We say a big thank

**Family & Friends of Goldsmith (FFG):** It was great to see so many parents at our FFG meeting last week. Thank you for coming and sharing your ideas for how we might move forwards. There were other parents who couldn't attend but have also offered their help.

A summary of areas discussed in the meeting;

- A fancy dress disco to be arrange for Friday 1st Dec 2023 this will de dependent on parents volunteering to help and also finding a DJ! Do you know a DJ with their own sound system and lighting who is free on Friday 1st Dec? If you do, please email the school admin account with the details so we can follow up after the half term.
- Holding used uniform sales once a half term from next half term we do need a small team
  of around 3 or 4 people who can take the lead on arranging them each half term.
- Having coffee mornings each half term so that parents can talk to each other and make stronger links with each other.
- Finding people from our range of communities and languages who would be able to talk to groups of people they know to try to get them more involved.
- Ideas were discussed for future movie nights and a cultural day but would be dependent on volunteers coming forwards.
- Raising money by using school newsletter for local businesses to advertise in.
- Choosing a goal or focus for fundraising each year with the school so that all events lead to raising money for those projects.

You will need to click on redeem your code and enter the unique number you have been sent.

You can then select your chosen retailer and your e-card will then arrive by email within 24 hours.

**Parking:** Coniston Gardens & Kingsbury Road Remember that cars should not be stopping or parking on the zig-zag lines for the safety of our children; nor should they be blocking residents driveways to help us maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.

- Cars should NOT STOP or PARK on the yellow zig-zag lines BETWEEN THE TIMES SHOWN
- Cars should NOT be blocking residents' driveways to help us maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.
- Cars should NOT be performing dangerous manoeuvres such as three point turns outside the main gate of the school or end up driving onto the pavement.
- Cars should NOT be parked in Holy Innocents Church car park on Kingsbury Road; it is their PRIVATE PROPERTY AND NOT A PUBLIC CAR PARK.
- Finally, please switch off your car engine if you are waiting around the school area to help reduce emissions in our local area.
