Staffing Update... I am sad to share with you that Mrs. Bhimji, LSA in Reception, remains on sick leave. Mrs. Bhimji suffered a serious health issue before the Christmas break. Dining Hall... there's good and bad news again!

The Good News - The new electricity meter is due to be installed on Monday 12th February which will help support further work to be carried out within the building. Also, the issue with the building management system has been resolved.

The Bad News - Whilst the issue with the building management system has been resolved, we have been told there is a six week manufacture and installation process for this key part of the building. We have been told that the new completion date for the dining hall project will be Thursday 28th March.

We will continue with the current lunchtime arrangements with hot meals being ordered and delivered from an offsite catering team. I will have a further meeting with the building team after half term and will write to you again with details when I have them.

#### **Parking Reminders:**

Coniston Gardens & Kingsbury Road Remember that cars should not be stopping or parking on the zig-zag lines for the safety of our children; nor should they be blocking residents driveways to help us maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.

- Cars should NOT STOP or PARK on the yellow zig-zag lines BETWEEN THE TIMES SHOWN
- Cars should NOT be blocking residents' driveways to help us maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.
- Cars should NOT be performing dangerous manoeuvres such as three point turns outside the main gate of the school or end up driving onto the pavement.
- Cars should NOT be parked in Holy Innocents Church car park on Kingsbury Road; it is their PRIVATE PROPERTY AND NOT A PUBLIC CAR PARK.
- Cars should NOT be parking in the disabled bar marked along Coniston Gardens.
- Finally, please switch off your car engine if you are waiting around the school area to help reduce emissions in our local area.






Please remember that the <u>school car park</u> and <u>Holy Innocents</u>
