LEAVE OF ABSENCE DURING TERM TIME (FOR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES)

Dear Families.

We ask you to support the school by ensuring your child achieves excellent attendance. Absence during term time can have <u>an adverse effect on a child's education</u> and our school actively discourages this.

Key Points:

- Leave of absence during term time is only granted under exceptional circumstances.
- A Leave of Absence Application form <u>must be</u> completed before the absence, with supporting evidence (please do not be offended by us asking). <u>If you do not apply for the leave of absence</u> in advance, the absence will be automatically unauthorised.
- Leave of Absence is granted solely by the Headteacher. Each case is reviewed individually.
- Family days out, holidays and visiting sick relatives are <u>NOT</u> deemed exceptional circumstances.
- Where a child is granted leave of absence, a date for return will be agreed in advance. If the child fails to return to school within 10 days of the agreed return date, the child's place at the school will be withdrawn.
- Unauthorised absences are recorded on our registers and referrals made to the Brent Education Welfare Service on a regular basis. This may lead to fines from the Local Authority.

What does OGPS deem exceptional circumstances and how many days are granted?

Exceptional Circumstance & Description	Number of Days Granted
Death or terminal illness of a person <u>close</u> to the child.	3 days
Wedding or Funeral of a person <u>close</u> to the child.	1 day
Religious Observance: The day of a religious festival exclusively set apart for religious	1 day per festival/religious
observance by the religious body to which parents belong as recognised by Brent	observance
Educational Welfare Service (EWS).	
Other significant community religious festivals/celebrations or pilgrimages that cannot be	Max of 2 days
