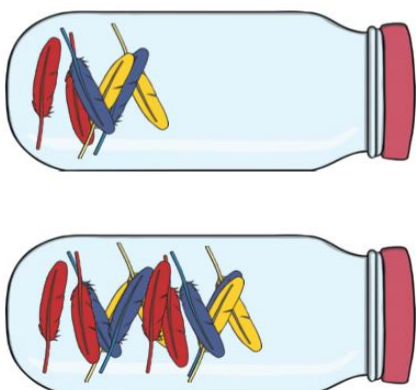
Circle the glass that is full.



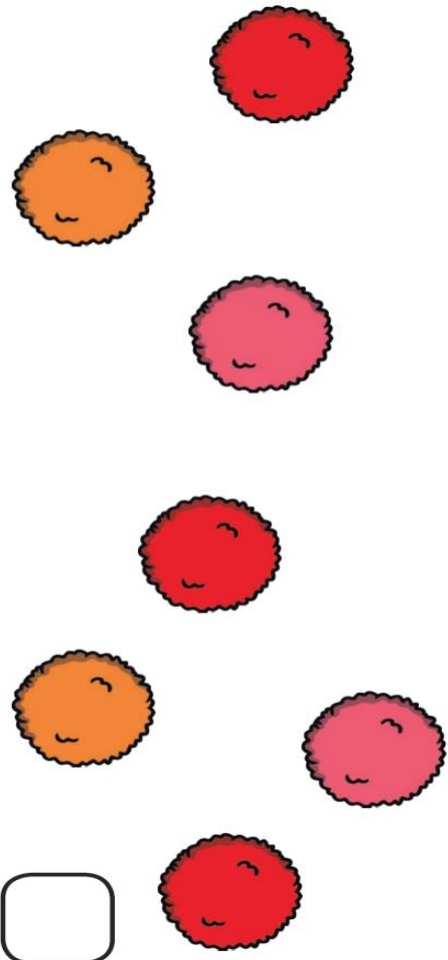
Colour all the number 7s.
