



Nursery Distance Learning - Week 6 Monday

Phonics:

1. Recap over previously learned sounds:

s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,ck,e,u,r,h,b,f,ff,l,ll,ss,j,v,w,y,z,zz,qu,sh,ch,th, ng, ee and igh. Remember to do the actions too. (use the flash cards or follow the instructions below to access the interactive way to recap over sounds)

Click on 'resources' and then 'phase 2' Scroll down to 'flash cards speed trial'

Click on 'pick individual grapheme' and select set 1-9 (excluding 'oa') Click on the 'correct' button every time your child remembers and pronounces the sound correctly.

2. Introduce new sound 'oa' by using the printed flash card or by writing down the sound. 'oa' for high. For this sound, can you stretch your arm up high and say the sound as you are doing so.

- 3. Practice saying the sound a few times by showing your child the flashcard or the sound written down. Can you work together to think of other 'oa' sound? I.e. goat draw a goat. Sound out and write the words together.
- 4. Practice writing the 'oa' sound on a piece of paper? Remember to use the correct letter formation and try your best!
- 5. Spread the phonics flashcards over the floor or write the sounds out on a paper. Say a sound and ask your child to find the sound by either picking it up or crossing out the sound once they have found it.







Tuesday

1. Recap over previously learned sounds and include the new sound 'oa'. You can either recap by flicking through the flashcards or by playing the interactive game from Monday, this time including the new sound 'oa'.


2. Can you complete the activities on the following pages?

Slowly trace your hand along the line. When you reach an oa sound, shout it out!












Find all the oa sounds and circle them.

- 1. First you will need to print out this page.
- 2. Stick the printed page on to a piece of card so your finger puppets will be stronger and last longer.
- 3. Carefully cut around the dotted lines with a pair of scissors. Ask an adult to help you with this.
- 4. Your finger puppets are almost ready. Now all you have to do is create a ring to put your finger in! You will see there is a bar at the bottom of each character, with a dot and square at each end. Join the dot to the back of the square around the back of the character and secure together with sticky tape.









Thursday


Phonics:
