

Learning Adventure for Art entitled "Amazing Artists & Curious Critics"

Specific Objectives of the ART Learning Adventure

- Each child AND adult in the school created a piece of art work that was displayed in a school community wide art exhibition.
- Learned about famous artists & their styles.
- Learned how to evaluate pieces of art, both in terms of preference but also techniques used
- Children took part in before and after evaluations to show how their critique skills improved
- Celebrate artistic skills at OGPS found our hidden artists & critics!

PROCESS WITH PUPILS IS KEY

- 1. Model & inspire them teach them options
- 2. Guide & monitor open questions
- 3. Pupils to keep evaluating what they are doing
- 4. Pupils to keep referring to skills continuum to think about their development
- 5. High expectations, for high quality outcomes!

















LEARNING PROCESS...

- What do you want to learn about?
- What you want to teach <u>visitors</u>?
- How will you <u>teach</u> them? (interactivity?)
- How will you <u>assess</u> if they have learned what you wanted them to learn? (activity?)
