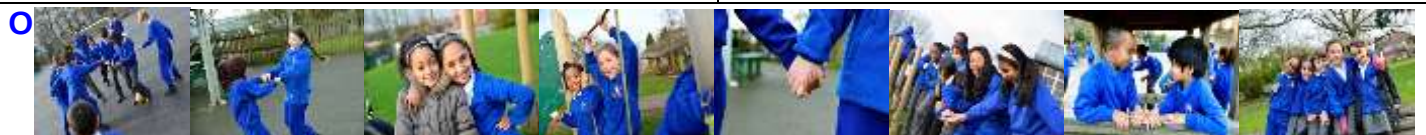
Our vision is to...
