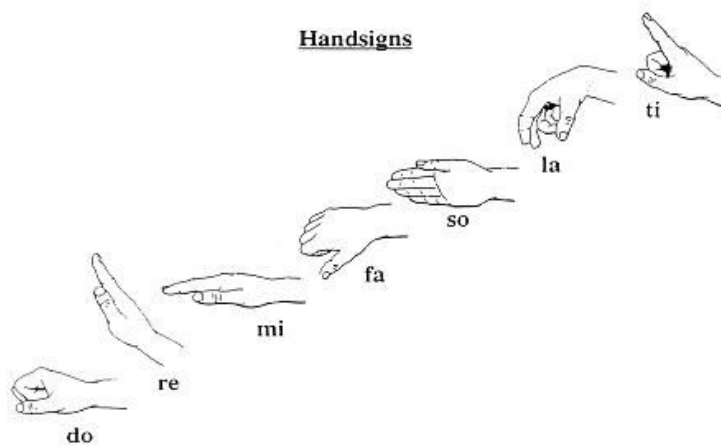
**Warm up:** Grab some wooden spoons and practise tapping to a steady beat with this BMS MusicsCool video:

Press the play button to hear the music you have created! Explore different compositions. Can you draw a train? A flower? A sun? What does the music sound like?

Step 1: Click on the squares to draw your design. Take care to make it detailed.

Step 2: To hear your song, press the large **play** button. You can also change the sounds by selecting different instruments using the next buttons along.

Step 3: How fast would you like your music to play? Change the **speed** of the music by changing the **tempo**. Make the music **faster** or **slower** by dragging the slider left and right.
